

Equal Educational Opportunities

Windham School District shall offer educational programs to all eligible inmates regardless of the inmate's race, religion, color, sex or national origin.

No qualified handicapped student shall, on the basis of handicap, be excluded from participation in, be denied benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any Windham School District program. 29 U.S.C. 794; 34 CFR 104.4 (a)

A "handicapped student" is one who has, or who has a record of having, or who is regarded as having a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities, such as caring for one's self, performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, breathing, learning, and working. 34 CFR 104.3

Windham School District provides a free appropriate public education to each qualified handicapped student. An appropriate education includes regular or special education and related services that are designed to meet the individual educational needs of the student as adequately as the needs of nonhandicapped students are met and that are based on adherence to procedures that satisfy federal requirements for educational setting, evaluation and placement, and procedural safeguards. 34 CFR 104.33

The principal on each campus is designated to coordinate efforts to comply with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and its implementing regulations. 34 CFR 104.7
